Dance Costumes

Dance outfits typically consist of a mask, cape, leggings and tail.

For example: a four-way transformation Thunderbird Mask transforming into a human ancestor.

Closed is measures 33" long by 14" wide.

Open at the widest point it measures 42" x 24" high.

Two horns are added, as well as ostrich feathers around the top of the mask with red and white cotton rope, or cedar bark

There are two pull strings used to open and close the mask.

The cape is made of canvas with designs on the front and filled in with white turkey feathers; the spine of the bird is in the form of a sculpin with white horsehair attached.

The carved feet and claws are attached to thermal underwear; rabbit fur, ostrich feathers and turkey feathers adorn the pants as well. The tail is attached to a leather belt and is worn belted onto the waste fitting onto the spine of the sculpin.
